Processes & Procedures

1. This scholarship is open to first year students only. You must submit an essay with approximately 500 words stating your financial need, your choice of post secondary institution (UNBSJ, NBCC or other) and your plans after graduation. Please note that the English post secondary institution must be located in Saint John.
2. Your essay must be submitted to the Saint John Newcomers Centre on or before Friday, July 30th, 2021 at noon. Any submissions received after this time will not be considered for review by our scholarship committee. The decision of the selection committee will be announced the week of August 15, 2021.
3. In the body of your essay you must not identify yourself or your family. You may talk about anything else that is relevant and your economic need for a scholarship. If you identify yourself or your family you will be disqualified from the scholarship review process.
4. When your essay is received it will be logged in and you will be assigned a number.
5. A copy of the acceptance letter from the post secondary institution of your choice, located in Saint John, must accompany your application.
6. Be somehow connected to the Saint John Newcomers Centre e.g. take part in any of our events, use our services now or in the past, etc.
7. Intend to stay in Saint John after graduation.
8. Intend to contribute to promoting multiculturalism in our city.
9. The essays will then be reviewed by two independent members of the Newcomers Centre of and they will choose the winner.
10. If you are the winner you will be contacted and asked to come to the Centre scholarship. A photograph will be taken as the award winner.
11. If you are the winner you will be asked by the Saint John Newcomers Centre to appear in media campaigns as well as provide written statements etc to be published now and in future years.
12. You may be asked by the Saint John Newcomers Centre to give a testimony as to how this award will or has helped you so as to encourage future candidates.
13. Page three and four of this application is for your essay.
14. Please sign and date the bottom of page 1. When you do this you are consenting to the use of your photograph both now and in the future as per the wishes of the Saint John Newcomers Centre.
15. All information should be type-written in the text boxes provided.

In 500 words or less, state why you want to pursue a post secondary education in Saint John, state your financial need, the post-secondary institution you choose and your plans after graduation in the text boxes on page 3 and 4.

Note: In the body of your essay you must not identify yourself or your family. You may talk about anything else that is relevant and your economic need for a scholarship. If you identify yourself or your family you will be disqualified from the scholarship review process.
